



Regulate Fake Clinics NOW!

Dear Representatives,

Crisis Pregnancy Centers (CPCs) deceptively advertise as comprehensive women's health clinics to lure women to their facilities, where they are pressured to choose pregnancy or adoption in lieu of abortion or birth control. Of the 4,000 CPCs nationwide, a Congressional study found that 87% provide false and misleading information about birth control and abortion. The American Medical Association, American Psychological Association, and the World Health Organization all dispel fake clinics' false claims that abortion leads to breast cancer, infertility, suicide, and that condoms are ineffective. Investigative reports from communities around the country document the deceptive tactics used to mislead women who believe they are visiting a comprehensive reproductive health center.

We urge you to support legislation that requires fake clinics to disclose in advertising and at their entrances that they do not provide or refer for abortions or birth control!
