While most effective within 24 hours, Emergency Contraception (EC) can be taken up to 120 hours after unprotected sex. EC is safer than aspirin and can be 75-95% effective in preventing pregnancy. The sooner you take EC, the more effective it is. So ask for EC at your student health center and visit www.overthecounterec.org to find out more.
